



### CINP Sumitomo/Sunovion Brain Health Clinical Research Award

The CINP Sumitomo/Sunovion Brain Health Basic Research Award will be presented at the 33rd CINP World Congress in Taipei, Taiwan, to a researcher in basic research targeting psychiatric disorders including schizophrenia and mood disorders. The recipient of the 2022 award will be chosen by an international scientific jury. This award consists of a monetary award of USD 10,000; an engraved plaque, complimentary Congress registration, round trip economy air travel; and up to three nights' accommodation at the Congress hotel.

- Candidates must be less than 55 years of age as of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022.
- Candidates must be nominated by a member of CINP. The nominee should be affiliated with a hospital, university, or research institute.
- The Awardee must commit to attend the 2022 CINP World Congress.
