



CINP Sumitomo/Sunovion Brain Health Basic Research Award

The CINP Sumitomo/Sunovion Brain Health Basic Research Award will be presented at the 34th CINP Hybrid World Congress in Taipei, Taiwan, to a researcher in basic research targeting psychiatric disorders including schizophrenia and mood disorders. The recipient of the 2023 award will be chosen by an international scientific jury. This award consists of a monetary award of USD 10,000; an engraved plaque, complimentary Congress registration, round trip economy air travel; and up to three nights' accommodation at the congress hotel.

- Candidates must be less than 55 years of age as of 31st December 2023.
- Candidates must be nominated by a member of CINP. The nominee should be affiliated with a hospital, university, or research institute.
- The Awardee must commit to attend the 2023 CINP Hybrid World Congress.

- 2) Up to five (5) published articles representing the work accomplished
- 3) A summary not exceeding two double-spaced typed pages explaining the significance of the contribution
- 4) Up to 500 words summarizing the basis for nomination
- 5) This completed form.
