# Why Attend

- Obsessive Compulsive Disorder (OCD) is a prevalent condition with a lifetime prevalence of 2-3% and clinicians should actively investigate its presence in patients with other mental conditions
- Patients with OCD and Obsessive Compulsive Spectrum Disorders (OCSs) often have the first symptoms during childhood and adolescence: child psychiatrists, psychologists, pediatricians often represent the first contact
- OCSs tend to be comorbid, chronic and very disabling. Duration of untreated illness occupies a great portion of the whole duration of illness.
- Comorbidity in OCSs is associated with gender-related features and specific longitudinal trajectories
- Suicidal behaviours are not uncommon in OCSs, particularly in comorbid subjects
- Poor therapeutic response and treatment resistance are frequently encountered in OCSs: optimization of guidelines-recommended interventions can significantly improve patients' outcomes
